In order to facilitate these activities, please follow the guidelines specified below:

1. School Sites – Cash donations collected at school sites should be deposited into a new trust fund account for Haitian Earthquake Relief with the school treasurer, pursuant to the procedures used for the collection of funds;
2. School Treasurers should cut checks weekly payable to The Foundation for New Education Initiatives, Inc.; with Haiti Earthquake Relief noted in the memo section;
3. Non-school site and/or individual donations should be made by check payable to The Foundation for New education Initiatives, Inc., and delivered to Room 776, SBAB, located at 1450 NE 2nd Avenue, Miami, Florida 33132; or online at <http://giveourstudentstheworld.org> and designate the donation for Haiti Earthquake Relief; and
4. Donations of non-perishable items such as tents, sleeping bags, mosquito repellent, lanterns, first aid kits, etc., should be delivered to a central location at the school. The school should then contact Dr. Marcos M. Moran, Assistant Superintendent, District/School Operations, at 305-995-7415 to schedule pick-up.
